Proposed Itinerary
 We are planning to leave school by 6:00 am (subject to change) on Tuesday 27th March and arrive back at school around 9pm (subject to change) on Thursday 29th March. The children will spend two nights away from home and will enjoy three full action-packed days at the Eden Project. We will travel there and back by coach.

Accommodation
 The Eden Project has a really unique hostel compared to the other hostels that are available to school parties. The rooms will be single-sex and the children will be with at least one friend of their choice. The accommodation consists of recycled shipping containers, all of which are ensuite and designed for three students of the same gender to sleep in. The rooms are all situated in rows and are accessed directly from outside, the doors lock automatically once it is closed. The doors can be opened from the inside by turning the handle but only from the outside by using a key card specifically cut to the individual room. There is also a lock on the inside that can be overridden with an emergency key card. Teachers will have copies of all the key cards to access their school's rooms.

Other schools or members of the public may be using rooms onsite, however, they will not be able to gain entry to any guests rooms that are not allocated to their school. Leaders are allocated rooms either end of the students' rooms.

Food and Drink
 Aside from a packed lunch on the first day, our stay will be fully catered. The children will be provided with breakfast, lunch and dinner every day, and will have access to fresh water and squash throughout the day. The menu is very child-friendly and usually includes two choices for the children; any specific dietary requirements will be communicated with the catering staff.


Health and Safety
 There is a First Aid centre onsite and a First Aider on call at all times. Parents will be provided with a medical and emergency contact form which must be completed fully and signed in order for the children to attend the trip. Any emergencies at home should be communicated to the school and the school will contact the staff on the trip. The children take part in their activities in groups of 6 with a fully qualified instructor and one member of Benhurst staff per group. At night, there will be one member of Benhurst staff to every 8-10 children.

If medical assistance is required there is a dedicated team of first aiders and a paramedic on site. Many members of the Youth Hostel are also first aid trained. There is a minor injuries department in St. Austell and an Accident and Emergency Department located in Truro. Transport would be by ambulance.
