PE	In KS1, children at Benhurst learn the skills needed to play games rather than learning common games. Practice passing balls using hands and feet, striking balls with a bat, aiming at a target, movement with and without equipment, team activities and spatial awareness.					
Music	In year 1 we are focusing on one song per half term. Each week we target different skills such as rhythm, learning song lyrics, song appraisal and using instruments.
