Feedback from research	Mrs Hart explained that she had reviewed the research and the team are all in agreement that exploring the idea of pets is a good idea but we still need to complete further research before we go ahead with this.	Mrs Hart
Pets options	The children had produced some excellent ideas for which pets we could choose to have. We used the extensive Year 6 research and discussed which pets would be a definite no for various reasons such as cost, pets which might be an option and pets we think would work. The children agreed on 3 pets to research further: tortoises, guinea pigs and hamsters.	Mrs Hart
Research groups	We discussed what else we might need to know about each of the 3 animals before we proceed. The children suggested: cost of animal, cost of cage, food and toys and vet costs in case of illness. The children agreed which of the 3 pets they would like to complete research for. Mrs Hart said she would produce a table containing their ideas for them to fill in with their findings. The children will have 3 weeks to complete this task.

Teacher Survey	We discussed the different people we would need to consult when making the decision about pets. We agreed	

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	to survey the teachers first as they would need to oversee the children looking after the pets. We agreed on the questions and created a questionnaire which was distributed to teachers
