Accommodation



We will be staying in YHA accommodation and all activities are on site. The bedrooms all cater for different numbers of children but they will all be single-sex and the children will be with at least one friend of their choice. The property also has a number of different toilets and shower rooms and two cosy lounges for the children to use.





Food and Drink



Aside from a packed lunch on the first day, our stay will be fully catered.

The children will be provided with breakfast, lunch and dinner every day, and will have access to fresh water and squash throughout the day. The menu is very child-friendly; for example, in the evening they serve both a cold buffet and a hot buffet, offering a choice of meat or vegetarian main course. All meals are served with two different vegetables and fresh fruit is always available. Any specific dietary requirements will be communicated with the catering staff.

Proposed Itinerary

We are planning to leave school by 7.00 am (subject to change) on Wednesday 10th April and arrive back at school around 4.00pm (traffic dependant) on Friday 12th April. The children will spend two nights away from home and will enjoy three full action-packed days at the Wye Valley. We will travel there and back by coach.

Health and Safety

There is a First Aid centre onsite. Parents will be provided with a medical and emergency contact form which must be completed fully in order for the children to attend the trip. Any emergencies at home should be communicated to the school and the school will contact the staff on the trip. The children take part in their activities in groups of 6 with a fully qualified instructor and one member of Benhurst staff per group. At night, there will be one member of Benhurst staff to every 8-10 children.
