- Booking 'Bling your Bike' and 'The Big Pedal' competitions for next year.

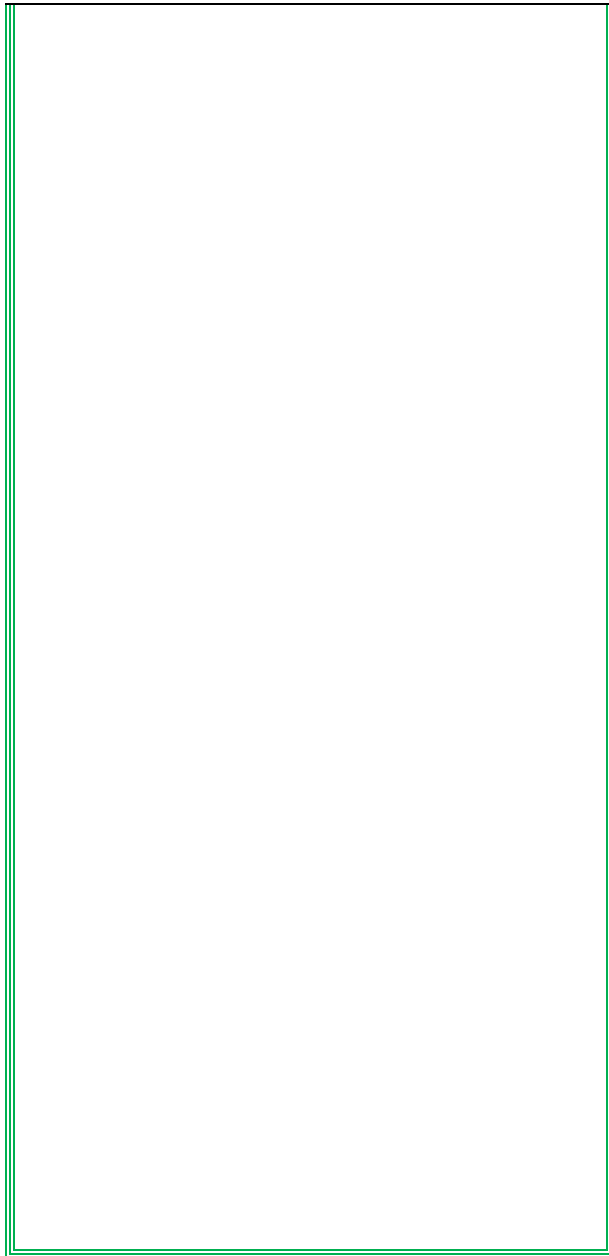
