Dear Parents and Carers,

Every year, Year 6 are take part in an enterprise project called The Fiver Challenge. Each pupil is given £5 to use to create a profitable business venture. Profits from the Fiver Challenge will go towards paying for the Year 6 Gala Dinner. Following the success from last year, the project again this year will involve planning and running half termly cinema evenings.

The first film evening will be held on Tuesday 11th February, 2020. We will be screening two films: one for KS1 and one for KS2 in the Year 6 classrooms directly after school.

Key Stage 1

Key Stage 1 (Year 1 and Year 2) are invited to watch 'Secret Life of Pets 2' (PG) which will be screened in 6L. Children will be collected from their classrooms at the end of the school day and taken to 6H.

Key Stage 2

Key Stage 2 (Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6) are invited to watch 'Toy Story 4' (PG) which will be screened in 6L. Children will be collected from their classrooms at the end of the school day and taken to 6H.

The films will start at 3.45pm and will finish by 5:15pm. The children should be collected from the Year 6 classroom doors at the end of the film. The children will be supervised by Year 6 staff throughout the film.

There are 40 tickets available per Key Stage for this event on a first come, first serve basis. The tickets are £2 each. For an additional cost of £1.50, you can pre-order a snack pack for your child which will consist of: a packet of crisps, a bag of haribo and a Calyspo drink.

If you would like to purchase a ticket for your child, please see the offer on SQUID. You will have to enter either £2.00 for film only or £3.50 for the film and a snack when purchasing your child's ticket. Unfortunately, we cannot accept any cash payments. There will also be an area for you to fill in who will be collecting your child once the film is finished.
