A few Y6 parents have enquired if we can hold an event on the field after school on our final day. Our Risk Assessment only permits 9 bubbles of 15 children for the summer term. The Risk Assessment is a legal document which has been agreed by the Trust Board and Local Authority and must be carefully followed. Whilst I realise this may be disappointing, we must continue to work within the current government guidelines and our risk assessment.

For those children who do not currently attend a Year 6 bubble class, Mrs Hillyer and Mr Light will be in the KS2 playground after school on our final day. This will give children the opportunity to say goodbye and to collect their books, end of year gifts and summer learning books (where ordered).

Y6 bubble children must return school library books, revision guides and any other school items during the final week of term. Non-bubble children may return school items from 3:30 to 4:00 on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> July.
