- Governors complete annual Skills Audits and contribute to a key area of responsibility within the school
- There are generally 7 meetings a year (during term time in the evenings) and one Saturday training day.

Prospective Governors will be invited to meet with the Chair of Governors, the Headteacher and a member of the Board of Trustees of LIFE Education Trust.
