## COVID-19: Year 2 Closure Notice

This evening, we have been informed of a positive lateral flow test result from a Year 2 staff member.

The staff member is awaiting results of a PCR test and we have been advised to isolate close contacts until the PCR result is received. **This currently means that pupils and staff in Year 2 must isolate until the result is received. Once the result is received, I will contact the parents of Year 2 children to advise next steps. If the PCR result is positive, the children and staff will need to continue isolating up to and including Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> July and may return to school on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> July. If the PCR result is negative, the children and staff may return to school immediately.** We are devastated that this closure affects our Year 2 children and staff once again and thank you for your understanding.

When self-isolating, it is essential that the children and staff do not leave the house unless for an emergency. Household members do not need to self-isolate as they themselves have not been in direct contact with the positive case.

Benhurst Primary School remains open for all other children. The Year 2 bubble will be provided with remote learning from Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> July via Google Classroom for the duration of their isolation. Please see your child's Google Classroom for further information.

### Can siblings still attend school?

Pupils in all other year groups, including the siblings of pupils who are isolating, should continue to attend school. We understand it may be a challenge for some parents to make the necessary arrangements to look after one child who is self-isolating whilst getting another child to school. Where it is not possible to safely bring siblings into school, we understand some children may be absent from school. Learning will be added to Google Classroom to support these children.

### Displaying COVID-19 symptoms or a positive test result

If your child displays symptoms or is tested positive for COVID-19, please email the school office and myself immediately and include a contact mobile number.

This will enable us to respond to any cases outside of school hours in a timely manner. We will confirm we have received your message. Please do not use this number for any other purpose than reporting a positive Benhurst pupil case

#### How to stop COVID-19 spreading

There are things you can do to help reduce the risk of you and anyone you live with getting ill with COVID-19. Do
