



In this unit pupils will learn the nouns and determiners/definite articles for 10 school subjects in French. They will also learn how to conjugate the verb 'to study', tell the time and expand the range of opinions. By the end of the unit, pupils will have the knowledge and skills to talk about the subjects they like and dislike at school (along with a justification) and say at what time and on which day they study various subjects. This will enable pupils to create more detailed and personalised responses by the end of the unit.

(the 'how')

Ensuring pupils are able to pronounce words in the foreign language more accurately and communicate effectively.

Recognise, remember & recall 10 school subjects in the foreign language with their correct determiner. Eg: *l'histoire*

Working on improving metacognition memory skills and encouraging the use of a dictionary for extra school subjects.

Using this verb to say/write what subject or subjects are studied at school. Eg: *J'étudie l'histoire.*

Using opinions and justifications to extend sentences and create more personalised responses. Eg: *J'étudie l'histoire. J'adore l'histoire parce que c'est amusant.*

Using knowledge of time to say/write which subject is studied at what time and on which day. Eg: *J'étudie l'histoire à neuf heures le lundi.*

Understand better that nouns in French have gender and this will impact the choice of article/determiner.

Understanding that verbs change much more in French than in English.
